SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS DUE 4/21/2024

The Agua Dulce Women's Club is offering scholarships to those enrolled in a 4-year college, community college, or vocational school in Fall 2024. The minimum requirements to be eligible for a scholarship are the following:

1. Applicants must have permanent residence in Agua Dulce or must have made a substantial contribution to the Agua Dulce Women's Club.
2. Applicants must be enrolled in a 4-year college, community college, or vocational/trade school in Fall 2024.

And they must be one of the following:

1. Graduating high school seniors.
2. Graduated high school seniors, having graduated in the last two years.
3. 1st or 2nd year college students with continuous enrollment in college since graduating high school.



While GPA and school performance are considered, these scholarships are not awarded solely based on those factors. We know our community is full of well-rounded, civic-minded young adults and recognize those are attributes that also prepare one for the future.
