

Agua Dulce Women's Club Hosts Free Lunch for PCT Hikers



Agua Dulce, June 8, 2024: The Agua Dulce Women's Club (ADWC) hosted a free lunch for Pacific Coast Trail hikers at their clubhouse on Saturday, June 8th. Club members and area residents sponsored a lunch for a hiker and were encouraged to attend the event to share a taco salad with the hikers.

This has become an annual event for the ADWC. Organizer **Julie White** said, "driving through town everyone always sees the hikers, and we wonder where they're from, and how long it's taken them, and why do they do it. It's just so interesting to talk to them because they're from all over," she said. "It's been fun,

you can see how happy they are."

Hiker Lauren Dunham, a realtor from Winter Garden, FL, said she appreciated the free lunch and to be able to sit in the cool clubhouse, recharge her electronics and herself for a couple of hours. This is her first time hiking the PCT trail. Her trail name is "Double Take" because she started the hike twice after being caught in a storm and getting altitude sickness, which forced her back to the start. Dunham decided she wanted to hike the PCT trail after spending a lot of time indoors. "I'd been stuck and needed to do something extraordinary," she said, adding her "desire was met with opportunity" when her mom retired and offered to stay



at her house and take care of her dog while she does her trek.

Hiker Mari (Magic) Hoffman from San Diego is doing the hike for different reasons. Her mother Cindy Katler Hoffman passed away from ovarian cancer in 2023. "My mom was fiercely confident and independent and modeled for me and my siblings to seek out your own sense of self. Hiking the Pacific Crest Trail has always been merely a dream for me, but my mom always encouraged me to pursue our dreams and make them a reality. I am hiking today to honor my mom and to embody the strength and resilience that she exemplified throughout her whole life." Hoffman has set up a website for donations to fund cutting-edge research for the early detection and prevention of ovarian cancer at https://pledgeit.org/maris-hike.

The food was donated by members of the club. \$10 tickets were sold around town for hiker lunches, so no hiker ever has to pay.

The Agua Dulce Women's Club, organized September 23, 1948, is a non-profit organization that hosts recreational and educational opportunities for the benefit of

the community, placing special emphasis on activities, scholarships, and support for the children of Agua Dulce. We serve as the casualty collection center for the Agua Dulce Disaster Preparedness Coalition providing food and shelter for the 1,700+homes in a rural community that may become isolated from emergency services in the event of fire or other natural disaster.
