



## Scholarships up to \$2,500

While GPA and school performance are considered, these scholarships are not awarded based solely on those factors. We know our community is full of well-rounded, civic-minded young adults and recognize those are attributes that also prepare one for the future.

The *minimum* requirements to be eligible for a scholarship are the following:

- Graduating high school seniors, living in Agua Dulce, or

- 1st or 2nd year college student, living in Agua Dulce, following continuous consecutive enrollment since graduating high school.
