August 26 is Women's Equality Day, which celebrates the 1920 ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment and, with it, women's right to vote in the United States. Ratification came in Tennessee, where Tennessee state legislator Harry T. Burn, age 24, cast the deciding vote after reading a letter from his mom, Febb Burn. "I know that a mother's advice is always safest for a boy to follow," he said, "and my mother wanted me to vote for ratification."

The country's 26 million voting-age women were enfranchised by this change in the Constitution. Longtime suffragist Carrie Chapman Catt summed up her experiences in the battle this way: "Never in the history of politics has there been such a nefarious lobby as labored to block the ratification." Upon ratification, Catt founded the League of Women Voters, an organization now dedicated to providing impartial, in-depth information about candidates, platforms, and ballot issues.

From my great grandmother, Ernestine Henrietta Viola Tiedemann of St. Louis, Missouri (1891-1977)

Strawberry Nut Salad

2 (3oz) pkgs strawberry Jello
1 c boiling water
2 (10oz) pkgs frozen strawberries, thawed
1 (1 lb, 4oz) can crushed pineapple, drained
3 med bananas, smashed
1 c chopped walnuts
1 pint sour cream

Combine boiling water with Jello until dissolved. Fold in strawberries, pineapple, nuts, and bananas.

Place half of the mixture in a dish. When set, spread sour cream evenly over the Jello mixture. Gently spoon the rest of the Jello mixture over the cream. Chill until set.




