#### AUDIO VISUAL EQUIPMENT TOWN HALL MEETIING

A Town Hall Meeting was held on Wednesday, June 14, 2023 using the newly installed audio visual equipment that was purchased with a grant awarded by the office of Supervisor, Kathryn Barger. The meeting, which is held on the 2nd Wednesday of the month via Zoom, was conducted both in-person at the Agua Dulce Women's Club and on Zoom. This meeting format called "hybrid" is an in person meeting combined with a virtual meeting online. This will continue quarterly. 
Going forward, there will be a hands-on tutorial/class for those members and groups who may want to use the equipment.

According to the DEA, 6 out of 10 illicit drugs on the street contain a lethal dose of Fentanyl. One pill can kill – It is 100 times stronger than morphine, 50 times stronger than heroin. Overdoses are on the rise. How do you respond to someone that has overdosed on Fentanyl? These are some of the important points that were discussed at the presentation held on June 22, 2023.





# Free Hands-Only CPR Training



#### BE THE DIFFERENCE FOR SOMEONE

Los Angeles County Department of Public Health is offering free trainings on Hands-Only CPR for community members. Hands-Only CPR is a life-saving skill that increases the survival rate of a person in a cardiac arrest emergency. We are asking our community partners to host these free and important trainings as a benefit for the people you serve. You play a significant role in helping us train as many people as possible.

#### Hands - Only CPR training is:

- A life-saving skill that will help you feel more confident to respond in an emergency
- A one-on-one or group session that lasts less than 10 minutes
- CPR without mouth-to-mouth breaths
- · Only to be used on teens or adults
- Easy; no documents are required from anyone who would like to be trained
- NOT a Certified CPR course. NO CPR certification is provided; if you need a certificate you will need to take
  a different course offered by a certified provider

The trainings will be conducted by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health staff at your facility. Trainings can be in various languages to accommodate the clients you serve. To host a training, please contact:


